# ICC'S 2014 MEDIATION EVENTS IN PARIS

## ICC Mediation Week | 6-12 February 2014

During seven days, ICC welcomes over 500 participants who are eager to discuss new developments in alternative dispute resolution, analyse and share experiences and meet with colleagues from more than 40 countries. In particular the Mediation Week features every year ICC's biggest educational event the International Commercial Mediation Competition.

## 1<sup>st</sup> International Mediation Round Table | 6 February 2014

The Mediation Week kicks off with a half day International Mediation Round Table for mediation practitioners and ADR academics offering a unique forum for exchange of best practices and new techniques. The International Mediation Round Table provides an interactive environment where topics relevant to the practise and international development of the field of practice and theory can be explored and debated.

## 9<sup>th</sup> ICC International Commercial Mediation Competition 7-12 February 2014

This annual event is the only moot devoted exclusively to international commercial mediation and is ICC's biggest educational event. ICC selects each year 66 participating university teams and over 120 professional mediators and corporate representatives from more than 40 countries to participate in this unique event. During six days the Competition will feature over 200 mock mediation sessions, as well as numerous training programmes and social events for no less than 500 participants. In mock mediation sessions, the students take the role of party or counsel in scenarios based on real international commercial disputes. Many of the world's leading commercial mediators participate as mediators and judges in the sessions.

## 1<sup>st</sup> New ICC Mediation Rules Workshop | 17 September 2014

This workshop will explain the new ICC Mediation Rules and offer participants the opportunity to acquire a comprehensive overview of the new Rules. Participants will have a direct exchange with several of the members of the Drafting Group, who will give a detailed presentation of the main provisions and provide participants with first-hand experience and understanding of the new Rules. Interactive group exercises and case studies will be used to provide participants with a practical insight into how the new Rules work. All sessions will be conducted by experienced users of ICC mediation, including company representatives, counsel and mediators.

## 5<sup>th</sup> ICC International Mediation Conference 18 September 2014

The one-day Conference offers a unique forum for more than 100 users of commercial mediation to exchange best practices and know-how. As the world business organization, the ICC's International Centre for ADR established the Conference to offer companies from around the world an opportunity to discuss techniques for effective conflict management, avoidance and early dispute resolution, as well as the efficient use of mediation. Accordingly, each year's programme is specifically tailored to the interests and needs of in-house counsel and management representatives.
